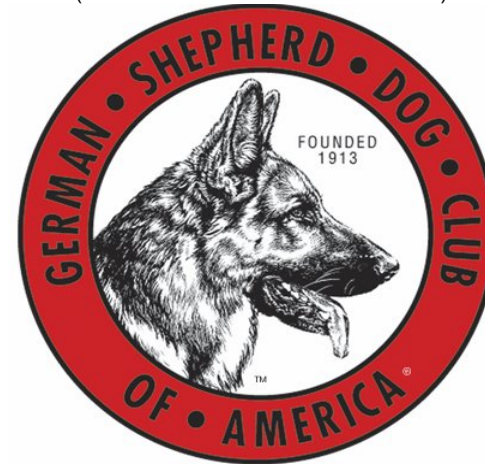

HEIGHT DIVISIONS:

Exhibitors are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. In the Regular classes, dogs may be entered at the jump height for which their measurement qualifies them or a higher jump height, if the exhibitor chooses. In the Preferred classes, however, dogs must run in the jump height for which their actual measurement qualifies them.

MOVE-UPS: Move-Up entries for Wednesday, October 17, 2007 will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date September 28, 2007. Email notification of move ups is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6:00 PM, October 10, 2007. Day-to-day trial move-up entries for Thursday, October 18, 2007 must be delivered to the Trial Secretary at the trial site, within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging on Wednesday, October 17, 2007 at the trial site. Move-ups are not allowed from Novice A to Novice B after the closing trial date. Dogs moved up will run at the end of the running order.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

THE SAFETY OF DOGS is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

TELEPHONE, FAXED, INCOMPLETE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS

without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT**

ACCEPTABLE. Unsigned entries or entries missing information other than the dog's call name will be returned.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed

ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted. **Entry Fees:** \$35 first class each

day! (includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee) / \$10 additional class, same dog, same day (includes

\$1.00 AKC additional entry recording fee). Make checks payable to 'GSDCA'. **RETURNED**

CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE. Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, **excused** by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of extreme weather, riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible or having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. If handlers have a ring conflict and so inform the gate steward, every effort will be made to accommodate you.

TRIAL COMMITTEE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR IN THE DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREA. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs

and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. **All exhibitors must pick up dog waste everywhere on the show grounds.** The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made.

All dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the AKC, or that have a Limited Registration or ILP, are eligible to enter this trial.

DOGS UNDER 6 MONTHS OF AGE ARE PROHIBITED AT AKC AGILITY TRIALS.

OBSTACLES: Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations For Agility Trials.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND TIMING: Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog. Umbrellas are not allowed on the course during the walk thru.

Electronic timing devices may be used.

BITCHES IN SEASON are not allowed to compete. There will be partial refund minus \$8.00 per day due to bitches which come in season after trial has closed, provided that the owner provide a veterinary statement to the trial secretary by the start of the trial on Wednesday, October 17, 2007.

Ribbons & Prizes

Offered Both Wednesday & Thursday

Rosettes will be awarded for First through Fourth place in all divisions.

Qualifying Rosettes will be award to all dogs receiving a qualifying score.
(Dogs must qualify to receive placements and awards)

New Titling Rosettes will be awarded to all dogs earning a new title in Standard, Jumpers w/Weaves and FAST (Regular or Preferred) Classes.

GSDCA Special Awards - Offered Wednesday Only

Etched beveled glass photo frames will be offered for First through Fourth Place in each jump height in *REGULAR AND PREFERRED STANDARD CLASSES*.

Agility Victor/Victrix will be awarded from the Regular Excellent B Standard and Regular Excellent B JWW classes using the following criteria:

- The dog must be entered both days of the trial
- The dog must qualify in BOTH the Regular Excellent B Standard and the Regular Excellent B JWW classes, therefore earning a Double Qualifier (DQ) on one or both days of the trial. Only Double Qualifiers will be used in determining the Agility Victor/Victrix.
- Double Qualifying on both days will supercede any single day DQ.
- If more than one dog earns a DQ on both days, or if only a single day DQ's are earned on the same day, then the dog with the lowest combined total time for those runs will be awarded the title of Agility Victor/Victrix.
- In the event of a single day DQ's being earned on different days the dog with highest yards per second* will be awarded the title Agility Victor/Victrix.

(*YPS = total yards of the courses that the DQ was earned on divided by the dogs times)

In the case that no dog earns a DQ on either day the award will not be given.

In addition to the above requirements, in order to be awarded Agility Victor/Victrix the dog may have no disqualifying faults as described by the AKC Standard for the German Shepherd Dog. This is to be verified at the time the award is given by an AKC Judge approved to judge German Shepherd Dogs. Spayed or neutered dogs who otherwise meet the breed standard are acceptable.

GSDCA Special Awards

High Scoring German Shepherd Dog, High Scoring Breed Champion of Record* and High Scoring Rescue German Shepherd Dog will be awarded from the Regular Standard classes using the following criteria:**

- The dog must be entered in Regular Standard class both days of the trial.
- *The dog must qualify in a Regular Standard class on one or both days of the trial.*
- Dogs qualifying both days in Regular Standard will have their two-day combined qualifying scores totaled. The dog with the highest total will win.
- In the event of a tie score, yards per second* (YPS) will be determined for both runs. The dog that has the highest YPS average will be awarded that award that they are eligible for.
- If no dog qualifies both days, but qualifies only on one day making it still eligible, the dog with the highest score will win. If there is a tie the dog that has the highest YPS* will be awarded that award that they are eligible for.

***YPS = total yards of the course(s) that the qualifying runs were earned on divided by the dogs time(s)**

In the case that no eligible dog earns a qualifying score in Regular Standard in any of the levels the award(s) will not be given.

* In order to be eligible for the High Scoring Breed Champion of Record Award, the dog must be a Champion when you sign up for the award on the first day of the trial.

** In order to be eligible for High Scoring Rescue German Shepherd Dog award, the owner must provide documentation that the dog is a rescue dog. Verification must be shown on the first day of the trial *or it may be sent in for pre-registration with the agility entry form*. Examples of acceptable documents: Adoption papers from a shelter or rescue organization, ILP number along with one of the following documentations: veterinary records demonstrating the conditions under which the dog was found, notarized statements of witnesses, etc. Direct any questions about eligibility to Diane Roberts, Board Member of the American German Shepherd Rescue Assoc., Inc. AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
