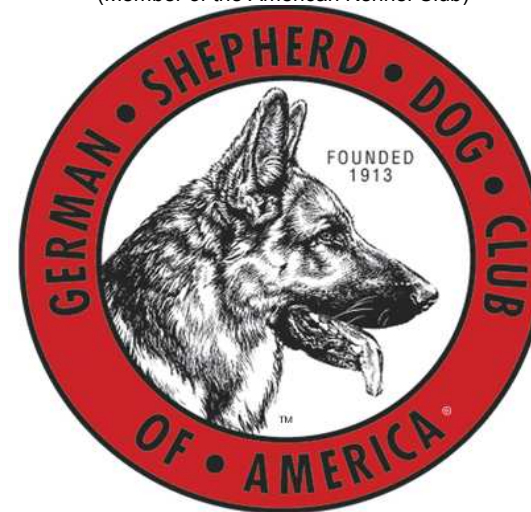

MOVE-UPS: Dogs may be moved up at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to **the Trial Secretary in writing**. (E-Mail is acceptable) All move-ups for Wednesday and Thursday, November 2 & 3, 2005 must be received by the Trial Secretary **no later than WEDNESDAY, October 26, 2005** at 12:00 Noon. Move-ups from Wednesday to Thursday must be submitted by the close of the trial on Wednesday.

BITCHES IN SEASON are not allowed to compete. There will be partial refund minus \$8.00 per day due to bitches which come in season after trial has closed, provided that the owner provide a veterinary statement to the trial secretary by the start of the trial on Wednesday.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

THE SAFETY OF DOGS is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations."

TELEPHONE, FAXED, INCOMPLETE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**. **Unsigned entries or entries missing information other than the dog's call name will be returned.**

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed

ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted. **Entry Fees:** \$35 first class each trial (includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee) / \$10 additional class, same dog, same day. Make checks payable to 'GSDCA'. **RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE. Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of extreme weather, riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible or having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. If handlers have a ring conflict and so inform the gate steward, every effort will be made to accommodate you.

TRIAL COMMITTEE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR IN THE DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREA. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. **All exhibitors must pick up dog waste everywhere on the show grounds.** The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made.

NOVICE CONTACT FAMILIARIZATION OFFERED ON WEDNESDAY ONLY.

All dogs 12 months of age or older that are registered with the AKC, or that have a Limited Registration or ILP, are eligible to enter this trial.

DOGS UNDER 6 MONTHS OF AGE ARE PROHIBITED AT AKC AGILITY TRIALS.

OBSTACLES: Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations For Agility Trials.

Agility Victor/Victrix will be awarded from the Regular Excellent Standard and Regular Excellent JWW classes using the following criteria:

- The dog must be entered both days of the trial. (Thursdays scores only will be used for Agility Victor/Victrix Award)
- The dog must qualify in BOTH the Regular Excellent Standard and Regular Excellent JWW classes on Thursday.
- Dogs qualifying in both classes will have their scores combined for the two runs.
- The dog with the highest combined qualifying score from the Regular Excellent Standard and Regular Excellent JWW classes at the conclusion of Thursday's trial will be awarded the title of Agility Victor/Victrix.
- In the event of a tie score, the dog with fastest combined time from both the Regular Excellent Standard and Regular Excellent JWW classes will be awarded the title Agility Victor/Victrix.

In addition to the above requirements: in order to be awarded Agility Victor/Victrix the dog may have no disqualifying faults as described by the AKC Standard for the German Shepherd Dog. This is to be verified at the time the award is given by an AKC Judge approved to judge German Shepherd Dogs. Spayed or neutered dogs that otherwise meets the breed standard are acceptable.

High Scoring German Shepherd Dog, High Scoring Breed Champion of Record* and High Scoring Rescue German Shepherd Dog will be awarded from Thursday's Regular Standard classes using the following criteria:**

- The dog must be entered in Regular Standard class on Thursday.
- The dog must qualify in a Regular Standard class on Thursday.
- The dog with the highest score shall earn the high scoring title it is eligible for. In the event of a tie score, the dog with the fastest YPS (yards per second) will be awarded the high scoring award.

* In order to be eligible for the High Scoring Breed Champion of Record Award, the dog must be a Champion when you sign up for the award on the first day of the trial.

** In order to be eligible for High Scoring Rescue German Shepherd Dog award, the owner must provide documentation that the dog is a rescue dog. Verification must be shown when signing up for the award on the first day of the trial *or it may be sent in for pre-registration with the agility entry form*. AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

From Charlotte, Kings Mountain & Gastonia (via I-85): Take I -85 North to Exit 48 (I-485). Turn right on I -485 East, travel to NC 49 (Harrisburg). Turn left on 49 North, through Harrisburg - cross under US 601(Bridge) and follow NC 49 3.2 miles. Arena will be on the left.

Or Take I -485 East to Exit 33 (Hwy 49N – Harrisburg). Stay on Hwy 49 North for approximately 13.5 miles. Arena will be on the left.
