ENTRIES NOT SIGNED WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED – Release Form

In consideration for participation in the Herding Instinct Test held by the GSDCA, I (we) agreed to assume all responsibility for any claim, loss or damage of whatever kind or nature, whether to person or property, which may be caused at or near the Herding Instinct Test, either directly or indirectly, by me or the dog or dogs I (we) have entered or brought to this Test. I further agree that I will hold the GSDCA, its officers, directors, agents and members harmless and defend them from any and all liability for injury, claim, damage or loss of whatever kind or nature, whether to person or property, caused at or near this Herding Instinct Test. I agree to indemnify the GSDCA, its officers, directors, agents and members for any loss, cost or expenses, including attorney fees and costs, which the GSDCA, its officers, directors, agents or members might be subject to as a result of any claim, suit, loss or damage caused in any way by any act of negligence on my part or one the part of any dog or dogs I have entered or brought to the Test. I acknowledge that, while the GSDCA may provide for the Herding Instinct Test, it does not have and does not exercise control over the conduct of those present. I certify and represent that the dog or dogs I have entered or brought to the Herding Instinct Test is/are not a hazard to other dogs, other animals, or to people.

I (we) will pay for injuries or replacement value in the event of death of any livestock by my (our) dog. If injury to any stock is caused by my (our) dog entered or brought to this Test, I (we) assume responsibility for any damages. I (we) agree to pay full market value for the injured animal in case of injury or the veterinary bill for the injury, whichever is agreeable to the stock owner.

ENTRIES CLOSE at Secretary's office at 6:00 pm Wednesday, September 19, 2007, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted. Changes, additions, corrections, or cancellations of entries must be received in writing prior to close of entries.

ENTRY FORMS MUST BE SIGNED AND JUDGE AND STOCK SELECTED. Please check entry form before mailing to make sure it is legible and that all of the dog's titles are listed.

ENTRIES SENT VIA FED EX, UPS OR EXPRESS MAIL MUST HAVE THE SIGNATURE WAIVED.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

TEST TRIAL LOCATION GROUNDS ARE AVAILABLE FROM 7:00 AM to conclusion of event.

Exhibitors are expected to maintain the premises in a clean and tidy condition. There is some shade for dogs and water is available. Bring your own crates, canopies, chairs, towels, etc. Bring appropriate wear for weather.

NO UNENTERED DOGS (EXCEPT SET-OUT DOGS) WILL BE ALLOWED AT THE TEST/TRIAL SITE. All dogs present must be held on leash or otherwise restricted except when working stock. Under NO circumstance will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena. Any dogs aggressive to persons or stock will be removed. (See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the American Kennel Club *HERDING REGULATIONS*).

NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED. **LUNCH WILL AVAILABLE ON SITE.** Please bring your own chairs, shade, etc. Water and soda will be available for sale. All American Kennel Club rules regarding conduct will be strictly enforced.

OWNERS OR THEIR AGENTS are solely responsible for the presence of their dog(s) and at test/trial arena. Judges are not required to wait for dogs.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. NO CONDITIONAL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS AND PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS WITHOUT THE AGREEMENT AND RULES ON THE REVERSE SIDE OF THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.

ENTRIES FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent (unless replaced by an Alternate), disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Test/Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or to complete the test/trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.

BITCHES IN SEASON shall be eligible and will run at the end of the class in tests and in catalog order as listed in the class in trials. Notify the Test Secretary if your bitch is in season. (See Chapter 1, Section 3 of the American Kennel Club *Herding Regulations*).

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE to arbitrate claims set forth on the Official AKC Herding entry form for this event.
