PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Dogs may not be shown unless entries have been received & listed in the show catalog (the only exceptions would be in the event omissions are due to printer's error).

Dogs must be from properly nominated litter, but owner does not need to be a member of GSDCA to show in the Futurity. A dog may be entered in any ONE of the nine regions, but may NOT be entered in more than ONE region. In order to be eligible to be shown in the Maturity in 2009, a dog must have been entered in the 2008 Futurity.

Exhibitors may not enter their dogs under the owner or co-owners, or any member of the household of the immediate family of the owner or co-owner of the sire or dam of their entry, or under someone with whom the exhibitor co-owns any dog. Judges, handlers, and exhibitors are required to abide by the AKC guidelines regarding handlers not showing under a judge for whom they have handled within a 4 month period.

**PRIZES**

Plaques will be awarded to the Best In Futurity & Best Opposite Sex to Best In Futurity in each region. The winner of each class in the Futurity Section will have its picture in the German Shepherd Dog Review.

The German Shepherd Dog Club of America, Inc. will award a Silver Medal to the Best in Futurity and the Best Opposite Sex to Best in Futurity at the National Specialty Show in 2008.

Three ROM points will be given to the sires & dams of the Best in Futurity & Best Opposite Sex to Best in Futurity at the the National Specialty Show in 2008.

If five or more animals are exhibited in this class at the National Specialty in 2008, the winners will be awarded the title of Futurity Victor & Victrix as determined by sex.

The Futurity Victor & Victrix each will be featured on a cover page of The German Shepherd Dog Review.

Entry in the class at the National Specialty Show for the winners of Best in Futurity & Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Futurity in each region & the reserves will be made by the National Futurity Chairman, & entrants agree by their signature on this entry to be governed by the rules & regulations applying to the National Specialty.

3. Dog may NOT be entered under the owner or co-owner, or any member of the household, of its sire or dam.  
Exhibitors may NOT enter their dog under someone with whom they co-own any dog.
4. Judges, handlers, and exhibitors are REQUIRED to abide by the AKC guidelines regarding handlers not showing under a judge for whom they have handled within a 4 month period.
5. Non-GSDCA members may enter the Futurity. Only GSDCA members may enter the Maturity. Membership application may be made with entry.
6. Check region carefully - region entered on entry form may NOT be changed after the close of entries.
7. Futurity entries must supply Litter Nomination number.
8. Maturity entries must indicate region entered in 2007 Futurity.
