AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons.

I (we) agree that any cause of action, controversy or claim arising out of or related to the entry, exhibition or attendance of the event between the AKC and myself (ourselves) or as to the construction, interpretation and effect of this agreement shall be settled by arbitration pursuant to the applicable rules of the American Arbitration Association. Notice to Exhibitors

✓ AKC fees include an event service fee of \$3.00 and a recording fee of \$.50 for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Obedience Trial and a \$3.00 recording fee for Rally. These fees are collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only (AKC Rules Chap. 11, Sec.2)

✓ Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering the trial, exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport.

✓ It is expressly understood exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fee paid will be made. Any incidents of dog aggression resulting in harm to other dogs or people that occur within the show grounds will be reported by the Show Committee to the proper authorities.

✓ All dogs *must* be on-leash, crated, securely penned, or otherwise under physical control at all times when not competing. Space is limited; please crate in designated area only and observe marked areas for seating. Only dogs preparing to enter the ring will be allowed in the ring area.

✓ Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from the competition by action of the Trial Committee

✓ No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by means of riot, civil disturbances, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, fire, or an act of God, emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

✓ Refunds: A refund of 100% of the entry fees will be given for any reason, if the request is received by the Trial Secretary, in writing or emailed, prior to closing. Entry fees shall be refunded for bitches in season, less \$5.00 per day entered, when a letter from your veterinarian is presented before 8:00 a.m. the first day of the trial.

✓ No refunds given under \$10 for your wrong addition. Checks returned from your bank will incur a \$20 charge.

✓ Dogs are not required to be at the Trial until scheduled time of judging; however, exhibitors are responsible for being at the ringside when it is their turn to run. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class. Please check in with the Gate Steward.

ENTRIES:

- ⇒ Entries must be the AKC specified size and include signature, fees, and agreement on the back or *they will be returned* to the exhibitor.
- ⇒ Entries are opened upon receipt and exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and LEGIBLE information on entry forms as well as correct fees; illegible or incomplete entries *will be returned*. Fill in all the blanks, please.
- ⇒ You *must* designate a Jump Height where applicable. Failure to do so presents an incomplete entry form, and it *will be returned*.
- ⇒ Please do not use staples.
- ⇒ Express Mail entries must include *your signature* permitting them to be left at the Trial Secretary's address, or they will be refused.

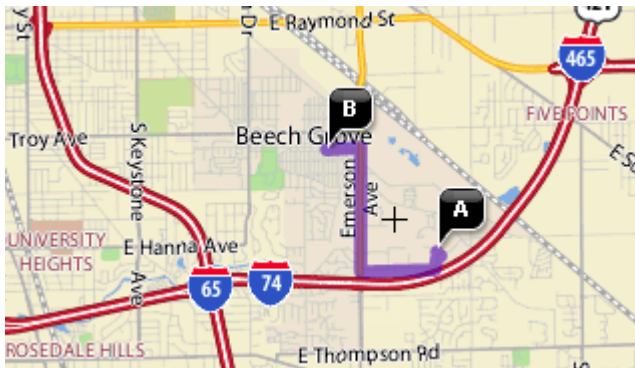

From I 65 N or S, from I 74 E or W and from I 70 E or W, or any other state highways that have exits for Interstate 465 in Indianapolis, take Interstate 465 to SE side of Indianapolis. Take exit #52 / South Emerson St. to the north to Main Street (approx 1 mile from I-465). Turn left (W) on to Main Street. PPOTC is on the left about 3/10^{ths} of a mile.

SITE INFORMATION

Trial Hours: SAT / SUN - 1 hour prior to the first class to 30 minutes following the conclusion of the last class, Eastern time.

Both rings are fully gated on a cushioned matted surface. There is air-conditioned, indoor crating in a separate room with AstroTurf flooring. **Please come prepared to put a waterproof mat or covering under your crate and chair.**

Please also understand that there is not enough room for non-currently-competing dogs in the room where the competition rings are located. We invite everyone to enjoy watching dogs competing in the ring but request the audience keep their dogs in the crating room until they are warming up their dogs and getting ready to compete in the ring. You are welcome to sit and enjoy being with your dog in the crating room. We appreciate your cooperation and support with this issue.

X-pens and crates may be left over night, but the GSDCCII or PPOTC will not be responsible for personal articles left at the site. No dogs may be left over night. No overnight vehicle parking is allowed. There is an RV campground near the building (see "Hotel Information").
