This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

Open. This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or <u>if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior</u> with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. **Master.** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition from the Open Class. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. Regulations Section 1- Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event.

Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed or member dog shows at the
 option of the show giving club.
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
- Closing date and time for this competition may be listed as any date and time prior to the event including the same day as the event and must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but
 must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any
 person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate
 cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the
 last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a
 professional handler.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS ENTRY FORM INFORMATION

- Closing dates for the entries is 6:00 p.m., Wednesday, March 8, 2023, at the SHOW SEC-RETARY'S address, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or substituted.
- 2. Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telegraphed or telephoned entries cannot be accepted.
- 3. Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms.
- 4. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of error, cancellation of the entries after the published closing date nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to incorrect entry.
- Changes or additional information cannot be made by telephone. Such information must be received in writing by email or telegraphed prior to closing of entries as published in the premium list.
