I acknowledge and agree that the German Shepherd Dog Fanciers of Northern California, German Shepherd Dog Club of America, Sycamore Lane Kennels, All Sports Dog Park, the American Kennel Club, and each of their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, the superintendents and/or the event secretary, and the owner and/or lessor or operator of the premises and any provider of services that are used to hold the event(s) and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, other participants, and any judge judging at the event (collectively the "Released Parties") are participating in the event(s) and allowing me to enter, participate in and/or attend the event(s) in reliance on my agreement to this indemnification, waiver of liability and assumption of risk agreement. I understand the AKC Regional Club hosting or co-hosting the event has the right to refuse my participation in, or attendance at the event(s) and of the holding of the event and/or the opportunity to have dogs judged and to win prizes, ribbons or trophies.

The Club and its Secretary caution all persons entering the show site and show grounds against all hazards which may exist, including, but not limited to: Condition of the site/grounds, parking/loading/unloading areas, entrances, floors and stairways, elevators and escalators, floor coverings, walkways, tenting/canopies, electrical appliances, cords and fittings, exercise pens, and the presence of animals. All persons should take into consideration this is a sporting event and dress, act and exercise caution appropriate for the activity involved. All persons entering the show, the grounds, site and show areas for whatever purpose do so entirely at their own risk. By virtue of entering the show, the entrant has indicated their acceptance of the terms listed in this premium list and assumes all risks involved. The Sacramento Valley Weimaraner Club, Inc. kindly request all exhibitors and visitors not to leave dogs in inadequately ventilated vehicles. If any dog at these events is suffering from extreme temperatures where it is confined without supervision, a California State Humane Officer or a Security Officer will be called to deal with the situation. If it is necessary to rescue a dog from a parked car on the show grounds, the club will not be responsible or liable for any damage to the car involved. Attention Owners/Exhibitors of Foreign Registered Dogs If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1. The dog show rules are posted on the AKC Web site at http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf. Most important to note are the following: 1. Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor class, 2. Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period of 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. The owner or agent can request an extension using the form found on the AKC Web site at http://images.akc.org/pdf/extenap.pdf. If you have question or need assistance with registration or obtaining an extension, please contact the AKC Special Services Department at: awards@akc.org or (919) 233-9767 (followed by selecting option 4)

SPECIAL COVID-19 TRIAL GUIDELINES Cont.

Our aim is to keep our judges, volunteers and exhibitors as safe as possible.

- 1. If you feel unwell, have a fever, cough, sneezing, sore throat (or any other symptoms that have been associated with COVID-19), please stay home.
- 2. If within 14 days prior to the trials you have been in the presence of a person who has either tested positive for COVID-19 or has th**e symptoms noted above, please stay home.
- 3. PHYSICAL DISTANCING: Maintain at least 6 feet between you and other exhibitors or spectators at all times. Avoid congregating to the extent possible. Avoid physical contact (shaking hands or hugging). Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
- 4. Participants should wash hands as frequently as possible. Participants must provide their own method for cleaning up from their dogs in and around the show grounds Prepare to be self- sufficient: bring sanitizer and personal use masks Do not congregate at the ring or ring gate

Know the armband numbers for your entries before going to the ring

- 1. I UNDERSTAND THAT PARTICIPATION IN, OR ATTENDANCE AT, ANY EVENT(S) INCLUDES THE POSSIBLE EXPOSURE TO RISK OF SERIOUS ILLNESS AND/OR DEATH AND OTHER RISKS FROM THE COVID-19 VIRUS AND OTHER INFECTIOUS DISEASES.

Things exhibitors need to know:

Loading and unloading is ONLY along the tree line on the south parking lot side. (This is opposite the pool) Cars should back into or front face the lawn. No parallel parking.

The areas marked off by cones in the parking lot are there for a reason...to keep cars out of that space. Do not remove the cones for access.

Dogs are not to go past the tree line.

The pathway between the kennel and the lake are off limits.

Dogs are NOT to potty on the lawn. This is a show lawn. We have events here each weekend.

Do not walk dogs along the wooden fence by the parking lot and stay off driveways. This is residential.

Potty areas are between the pool and the vineyard, the two runs behind the pool and the lawn under the oak tree. These are the only designated areas. Exhibitors are expected to clean up after their dogs.

Dogs are not to be walked along the perimeter of or in the vineyard.

Dogs must be on a leash. This doesn't mean your dog is wearing his leash. A human must be holding the leash.

Under no circumstances are dogs allowed near the kennels, in the bathrooms or down the lane. All dogs are expected to stay in the event area which is designated by the trees along the lawn and the unloading/loading area. See the map for details.

Parking is always in the RV lot unless prior arrangements were made with All Dogs Sports Park.

The club or individuals are not to save parking spaces. Spaces are first come first served.

Only the event crew setting up will have access to the arena area by vehicle. All others are prohibited. These vehicles can park along the vineyard for unloading and loading only. They must then be parked in the designated parking lot. The paved area between the lake and the arena, and the dirt between the arena and vineyard is off limits to vehicles.

Vendors must be cleared by All Dogs Sports Park, provide a sellers permit and proof of insurance. There is a charge for vendors.

There is absolutely no parking in front of the training building or near the kennel.

All yards are off limits unless included in the contract.

ANYTHING with a flat bottom must be removed from the lawn at night. Anything with a flat bottom left on the lawn will be discarded by All Dogs Sports Park staff. This includes crates, mats and collapsed awnings.

Any damage to the lawn or arena by the hosting club, dogs or their handlers will be billed to the hosting club.

All garbage must fit into the cans. Anything left outside the can will cost the club a removal fee as specified in the contract.

The arena lights must be turned off each evening before leaving. If not \$100.00 per night will be deducted from the security/damage deposit.

- IF MONEY IS OWED TO GERMAN SHEPHERD DOG FANCIERS OF NORTHERN CALIFORNIA, ENTRIES AND PERSONAL CHECKS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNTIL ALL MONEY OWED IS REMITTED BY MONEY ORDER OR CASHIERS CHECK. RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY.
- 2. The club assumes no responsibility for a wrong entry. Please PRINT or TYPE all information on entry blanks.
- 3. During the hours of judging, owners are to be on call and to have their dog ready to be brought into the judging ring promptly so the judging will not be delayed.
- 4. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his or her dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs are alone responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- 5. There is no rule of this Club or of the AKC that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his or her dog into the ring.
- 6. An exhibitor whose dog is eligible for an award must be present or have an appointed representative to accept the award for him or her.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, in season, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.
- 8. Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates.
- 9. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is understood that the exhibitor will exercise control over his or her children on the day of the show.
- 10. The Club assumes no responsibility for dogs or equipment left unattended.
- 11. All dogs must be kept on leash.

Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chiuahuaus (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard),
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
