Notice to Exhibitors

- Make all checks and money orders payable to the German Shepherd Dog Club of Western Pennsylvania (GSDC of WPA).**
- Mail entries to: Barbara Blanchfield; 1322 Foxwood Drive; Monroeville, PA 15146.**
- Entries received without fees or correct fees** will be returned to sender. Credit cards cannot be accepted. Make fees payable in US FUNDS. Trial secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Post dated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- Exhibitors will pay** all bank charges for bounced checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.
- Declination of Entries.** GSDC of WPA may decline any entries and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against GSDC of WPA, or any official thereof.
- Express mail entries** must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Show Secretary's address. Mail requiring signatures will be returned to sender. Faxed or e-mailed entries cannot be accepted. **No online entries will be taken for this trial. Payment must be included with the entry.**
- Entries must be on the Official AKC Entry Form** Entry forms without the AKC agreement, attached to the entry form, are NOT ACCEPTABLE and will be returned to the exhibitor. Unsigned, and incomplete entries are not acceptable and dog cannot be entered in the trial. (AKC Rule Ch 14, Sec 4)
- Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor.
- Entry form changes,** additions or corrections must be received in writing prior to the April 19th closing date and time.
- No refund for duplicate entries.** Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries; however, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.
- Owners are responsible** for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
- A dog withdrawn** from the trial after the event's closing date and time due to a change of judge will receive a refund specifically for any runs under that judge only.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded** in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- No Refunds for Bitches in Season**
- No entry fee will be refunded** if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- GSDC of WPA will not be responsible** for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.
- It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The GSDC of WPA and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- The safety of the dog is our primary concern.** By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all portions safely.
- All Dogs** present at the site must be on leads when not being judged, except when in the warm-up area or competing in the ring
- Dogs may arrive** any time prior to judging. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.
- Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
- The club will not be responsible for the loss or damage** to any dog exhibited whether the results of accident or other causes. It is distinctly understood that every dog at these events are in the care and custody and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the event grounds. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that exhibitors will exercise control over their children on the event grounds. The club is not responsible for theft or damage to vehicles or personal property. The Event Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dog or exhibitor participating in these events.
- All trophies must be claimed** on the day of the show. None will be mailed.

***From the intersection of Rt. 22 and Rt. 66:

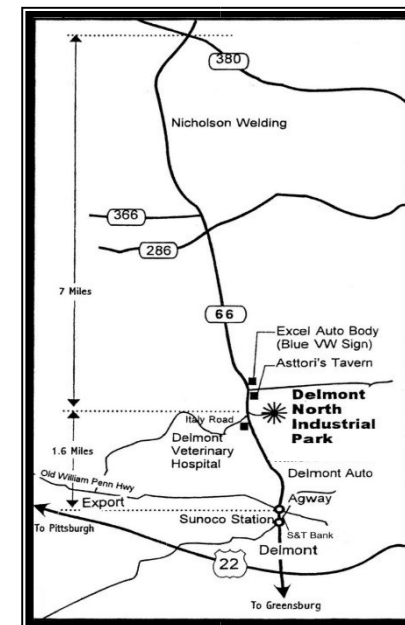
Continue north on Route 66 (2.9 miles) through two traffic lights, past Delmont Auto Sales and Valero's RV Sales. Just after you pass the Delmont Veterinary Hospital on the left, turn RIGHT into driveway for the Delmont North Industrial Park. Continue to the buildings at the top of the hill.

From the South or East

Take the PA Turnpike or Interstate 70 to the New Stanton interchange. Follow PA Toll Road 66 North to intersection with Route 22 (13.8 miles). Pass under Route 22 and follow directions from ***above.

From the North

Take Route 66 South. From the Route 380 intersection, continue 7 miles south. Past the blue VW sign for Excel Auto Body, turn left into Delmont North Industrial Park. Continue to the top of the hill.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event...

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color) Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles, and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in the Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a Championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for the mixed breed entrants.
