# ATAA Committee Report (as of 9/30/18)

I am pleased to report that the updating and revamping of the Annual Training Achievement Awards Program (ATAA Program) has been completed and we are all ready for the 2018 award year submissions!

The updated forms and information have been forwarded to the GSDCA Webmaster and will soon be up and available for all.

What was accomplished was:

1. Updated the description of the program as it stands currently.

2. Updated the reporting submission form for titles for progeny to make it more straightforward and easier/less time consuming to be filled out by each submitter.

3. Created a new Judge's Attestation Form to use when submitting a new dog into the program for the first time, certifying that the dog has no disqualifying faults. This form does not have to be used, but it will be easier for most to have it available or at least act as a template for what is needed for submission.

4. Revamped the entire title point structure to include a point amount for each AKC/SV/SAR title reflecting the level of difficulty and the amount of training that go into earning each title. Of course this is a continual work in progress as new titles are being added all the time.

#### **October 2018 Futurity Committee Report**

After several years of decreasing participation, the 2018 Futurities held steady with a slight increase in the number of dogs shown.

The Committee met multiple times during the year and worked to promote awareness, enthusiasm and to support the regional host club. We are happy to have played a part in providing a spring weekend for GSDCA members across the country to enjoy and breeder members to exhibit their up and coming youngsters. Entries may never return to the levels of the "glory days" but Futurities do help support the regional host clubs monetarily by the GSDCA profit generated, and by the increased entries for the accompanying specialty shows. For 2018, the profit from the GSDCA to each regional host club ranged from a low of \$615.56 to a high of \$3255.16.

The Futurity Committee requests action on the following items:

- 1. Approve a date change of the 2019 Northwest Futurity from Saturday May 11, 2019 to Sunday May 12, 2019.
- 2. Approve the following changes to the class first through fourth place plaques:
  - Decrease plaque size to 7x9 @ \$9.50 each for first place and 6x8" @ \$7.50 each for second, third and fourth.
  - Change information on the plate to "German Shepherd Dog Club of America Regional Futurity/Maturity." Because the plate info is generic, Bruce Gilbert has agreed to ship the exact number of plaques needed when we receive the entry counts after each closing. If unused due to absenteeism, they can be recycled without any additional labor.
  - Instead of the flat metal logo on each plaque, medals similar to the GSDCA Best of Breed would be used. The medals are not included in the prices above, and would be purchased in bulk and paid for by the live streaming donations.
  - This scenario would allow us to do away with the mail in requests for second, third and fourth as exhibitors do prefer to receive the plaque at the show. The procedure of plaques being requested by mail has saved money for the last two years, but may well cost money in the future due to a decrease supply of recycled plaques. New plaques of current size are \$15.75 each.
  - Had we used the smaller plaques with generic info on the plates in 2018, there would have been an approximate savings of \$420 as compared the current procedure.
- 3. Allow <u>OPTIONAL</u> GSDCA Fun Matches to be held by regional host clubs during their Futurity weekend which would be facilitated by the Futurity Committee. FYI: Per AKC rules, fun matches may be held by licensed clubs if entries are accepted from club members only. Thus, puppies must be owned or co-owned by GSDCA members to be eligible for these fun matches.

A debt of gratitude is owned to the members of this committee whose hard work is a measure of their belief in the Futurity System. Many thanks to: John Ayotte, Linda Bankhead, Holly Bryan, Helen Gleason, Christine Grainger, Jeanne Hamilton, Patty Korsch, and Candy Zumwalt.

#### *Review* Marketing <u>NO ACTION REQUIRED</u> 2019 Projections are in blue

#### October 1, 2018

In 2018, four new programs were developed for the Review:

- 1. **Spotlight On Our Juniors** (began in April, 2018 issue). This feature has been extremely well received by the membership. All eligible junior handlers featured in 2018 made the AKC's Top 20 Junior Handlers of German Shepherd Dogs. This column will be continued in 2019.
- 2. The World of GSDs (began in September, 2018 issue). Both Mr. Gyu Cheol Shin, GSD fancier and President of the Korean Kennel Club, and Dr. Iruo Jung, veterinarian and director of ICSB-Korea, gave us insight into both the workings of dog clubs and the methodology and use of frozen semen in Korea. We are currently working with individuals/translators in other countries and plan to present their interviews/articles in 2019.
- 3. **Regional Club News** (began in June, 2018 issue). This column gives GSDCA member clubs the opportunity to share ideas and discuss activities. The first club to participate was the GSDC of the San Gabriel Valley. Another club will be featured in the November/December issue of the *Review*. More regional clubs have expressed interest in being featured and this column will be continued in 2019.
- 4. Sit...Stay...Shop (announced in late spring, 2018) For a reasonable fee, GSDCA members are able to announce litters, list dog-related items/services for sale and seek items/services needed. Fees depend upon length and/or inclusion of photos. To date, the membership has made little use of "Sit...Stay...Shop" but, as there is no cost to either the *Review* or the GSDCA in maintaining its availability, we will continue to offer it in 2019.

The *Review* is offering the membership two "specials" for the November/December, 2018 issue. The first special is for regional clubs and allows them to celebrate the successes of their membership for a reduced rate of \$100/page (B&W only, camera ready.) A Constant Contact that announced this special was sent out on August 10, 2018. The second "special" is the return of the business-card sized "Holiday Greetings" ads at a rate of \$65.00/ad, (full color, camera-ready.) The return of these ads will be announced to the membership immediately following the national.

In 2018, we solicited articles from experienced and successful breeders and/or exhibitors in every venue. The response was overwhelmingly positive; only Agility and IPO failed to submit their articles. Articles such as those which appeared this year will continue to be considered and welcomed. As always, any original article is subject to editing and submission does not guarantee publication.

In 2019, the *Review* seeks to develop projects and promotions which both enhance the publication and educate the membership. We have a good team of individuals in place to ensure the continued quality and accuracy of the publication.

There are less than a handful of members who are still not receiving the *Review* with any timeliness or regularity. As we cannot control the USPS, we will continue to work with the membership chair to resolve these few situations.

In 2019, ad rates must be revisited. The Editor and *Review* committee will work with both the Treasurer and Budget and Finance on this project. Ad rates need to have built-in incentives for potential advertisers while ensuring a break-even or profitable status for the publication.

# **Dual Award Committee Report for 2017-2018**

To the GSDCA Officers, Board of Directors, and Committee Chairs, the following is the report for the 2017-2018 Dual Award year.

This year there are thirty-two names on the Dual Award list of recipients. Of these thirty-two, four of the dogs received their Dual Award plaque in a previous year and earned additional titles this year. Our members are keeping themselves and their dogs busy and involved in multiple venues and advanced titles. We awarded plaques in Rally, Novice and Excellent, obedience, Companion Dog and Beginner Novice, herding, Pre Trial tested, Herding Tested, and Herding Started Course C sheep, lure coursing, BCAT, and agility, Agility Excellent Preferred, Excellent Jumpers Preferred, Masters Excellent Jumpers.

We had eleven Dual Award Excellent recipients this year as compared to fifteen from the 2016-2017 year.

Dual Award information can be sent in as soon as the dog is eligible. Each year there is the mad rush to get all information in by the deadline of July 31. This year was exceptionally hectic with 23 orders being processed in the month of July. I would like to find a way to avoid this crush as it increases the likelihood of mistakes being made. No one wants to see that their dog's name and accomplishments has been missed in the National catalogue or the Review.

### **GSDCA** Legislative Report

The Legislative Committee has concentrated on alerting Regional Clubs throughout the US when harmful legislation, ordinances, or bills are introduced in their region. We have contacted Officers of Specialty Clubs requesting a member of the Club to be appointed to receive alerts. This effort has had limited success as Specialty Clubs continue to decline in membership numbers. We have also contacted All Breed Clubs. Many All- Breed Clubs with large memberships have an active Legislative Member and they do respond to our emails.

We have asked permission to briefly address the Members at the Annual Membership Meeting at this year's National. The Membership Meeting provides a unique opportunity to reach out to our members from throughout the US. We will ask members to follow the actions of their City Counsels, to be informed by checking Legislative Actions and Bills introduced in their State, County, and City. Many times we are behind the curve; we learn of harmful legislation, bills, or ordinances the day before a vote – too late to react in the best interest of our rights and our sport.

The Animal Rights people are hard at work having introduced close to 100 bills or other action items. A seemingly harmless ordinance addressing how many hours a dog may be tethered is frequently the first step leading to their ultimate goal – no ownership of intact females, no litters, etc.

The Legislative Committee will continue their efforts to raise awareness among our members and to contact members in areas where Animal Rights are seeking significant changes affecting rights of ownership and breeding. It is critical to raise awareness among our membership, their families, friends and neighbors.

In physical year 2019 we hope to introduce an action plan to the GSDCA Board which will include the development of a simple educational and informative handout.

### RALLY REPORT FOR OCTOBER 2018

1. Since the addition of a Class Higher than Excellent, we respectfully request that the Victor/Victrix award be changed to add the Master Class to the requirements for this award as follows:

A score of 97 or better in the Master Class and a score of 99 or better in both Advanced and Excellent for a total combined score of 295 out of 300

THE RAE or present high combined remains unaffected and unchanged at the AKC

The section in the PandP should read: (changes in red)

#### **RALLY VICTOR/VICTRESS**

- The highest Combined RAE at the National Show Only with a minimum combined of 198 of 200. Trophy but no Review Cover. In 2018, the new Master Class will be added to the requirement with a score of 97 or better for a tital combined score of 295 out of 300.
- Dog must have no disqualifying faults as described by the AKC Standard for the German Shepherd Dog as verified by any licensed AKC judge, at the discretion of the Rally Chair, pass upon the Rally Select.
- The Dog must AKC Registered, not ILP. Regardless of AKC rules, spayed/castrated dogs that otherwise meet the Standard are acceptable.
- As with all GSDCA awards, one owner must be a member. Trophy but no cover of the Review.One owner must be a GSDCA member as with any Parent Club Awards

2. We ask that the new title of AKC RACH title be recognized by the GSDCA and added to other programs. This is a Title (not a class) similar to the OTCH, MACH etc.

3. We ask that the Preferred Award for the year stats from 2018 onward now include the Master Class stats. At Present, we use only the ADVANCED B and EXCELLENT B to determine our High Scoring Rally Dog

On a Sad note, this August our Three-peat High Scoring Rally Dog passed away. She was on her way to her RACH with all triples and half the points. Our condolences to her Owner Gail Phillips. RIP Sasha
