## 4-6 MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION

(EVENT # 2023009371)

**TUESDAY, OCTOBER 24, 2023**

The 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition is open to all German Shepherd Dogs and shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months of age on the day of the Show. This will be one class with no separation of sex. AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*. A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin. All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol. Exhibitors should open their dog's mouth for examination. If the judge finds it necessary to open the mouth they should disinfect their hands prior to examining other dogs. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler. Judges will comply with the *Rules, Policies and Guidelines for Conformation Judges* except the speed of judging may be reduced to 20 dogs an hour. Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy competition may be offered in a separate ring(s) from the regular class judging in order to avoid delays in the judging of regular classes. Entry fees will be determined by the show-giving club and no recording or event service fees will be charged for this competition. Clubs holding Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy competition will receive credit for completing both a Major Activity as well as an Additional Activity for judges gaining experience on their unapproved breeds by judging at the event. *Dealing with Misconduct* will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise. Entries Close at the address of the Show Secretary at **6:00P.M. (CST), OCTOBER 5, 2023**. Show Secretary: Valerie Harrington, 15 Creigmont Ct, Crossville, TN 38558.

**Dogs** need to be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the clubs nor show secretaries will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class being judged. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates.

**Judges** need not wait for any dog holding up the judging of a class. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dog(s) in the judging ring.

**Dogs to be** exercised in designated areas only both at the show site and hotels

**Dogs must be** kept on leash at all times while on show grounds

**Unattended dogs** must be crated in hotel rooms

**Dog owners/agents** are personally responsible to area hotels for any damage caused thru their negligence.

**Entry fees** will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or a judge; or barred from competition due to their violation of any rules or regulations set forth by the show-giving clubs.

### **NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES.**

**No fees** will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the show-giving club or show secretary.

**Returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be \$40 fee on returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash only basis. Canadian exhibitors: make checks/money orders in U.S. funds.

**Entries** will be acknowledged after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program sent to **EMAIL address on entry form**. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time contact the Show Secretary.

**Refunds** for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent **AFTER THE SHOW**. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to closing.

If **veterinary attention** is required, the exhibitor is responsible for the veterinarian's emergency fee and medical expenses incurred.

**LOSS OR DAMAGE** – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. 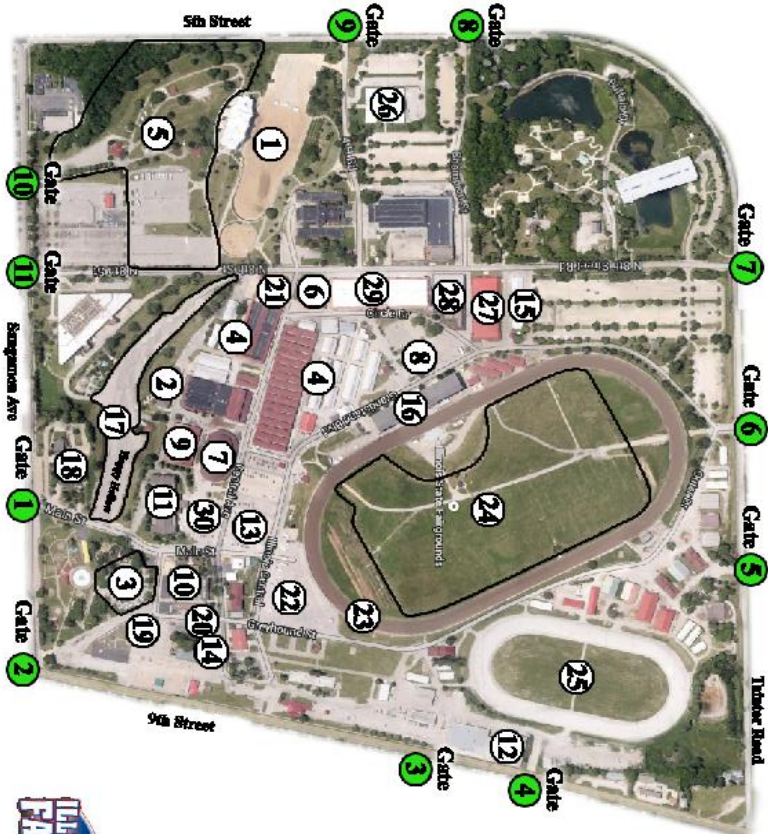
