## **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP** **German Shepherd Club of San Gabriel Valley, Inc.**

**Novice.** This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open. after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

**Open.** This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

**Master.** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition from the Open Class. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors Meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

**EACH DOG ENTERED MUST BE OF THE BREED FOR WHICH THIS SHOW IS HELD.**

Junior Handlers must put their Junior Handler's number on the entry blank. To obtain a Junior Handler number, call the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776 or E-mail at juniors@akc.org.

**Notice:** Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form. By signing the entry form, certification is given that the Junior Showman does not now, and will not at any time, act as an agent/handler for pay while continuing to compete in Junior Showmanship.

Each dog handled in a Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including step and half relations or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. **BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE-** A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the Veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier. Winning of first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC, go online at [www.akc.org](http://www.akc.org).

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### **4-6 MONTHS BEGINNER PUPPY**

#### **Regulations**

##### **Section 1- Classifications**

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event.

##### **Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility**

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed or member dog shows at the option of the show giving club.
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
- Closing date and time for this competition may be listed as any date and time prior to the event including the same day as the event and must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.



## **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

### **ENTRY FORM INFORMATION**

1. Closing dates for the entries is 6:00 p.m., Wednesday, March. 6, 2024, at the SHOW SECRETARY'S address, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or substituted.
2. Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telegraphed or telephoned entries cannot be accepted.
3. Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms.
4. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of error, cancellation of the entries after the published closing date nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to incorrect entry.
5. Changes or additional information cannot be made by telephone. Such information must be received in writing by email or telegraphed prior to closing of entries as published in the premium list.
6. Entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club or Show Chairman.
7. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Club Treasurer will add a collection fee of \$20.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.
8. Refunds for cancellations prior to the closing will be made after the show.

12. Email confirmation will be provided. Please include a legible email address on your entry.

14. A recording fee of 50¢ and an event service fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show, obedience trial or tracking test. This recording fee is to be collected (as part of Entry fee) by the show giving club and paid to the AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 14, Section 20).

### **JUDGING**

1. These shows will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. daily.
2. There is no provision for un-entered dogs at this show.
3. Dogs must be ready for judging. No provisions are available for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judgingring.
4. Dogs need be at the show only at scheduled judging time and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging.
5. This show is un-benched.

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Set-up in designated areas only.
2. All dogs must be held on leash or kept in crates or pens except when being judged.
3.
