

DIRECTIONS TO SITE:

We are located on the eastern side of Cincinnati, convenient to SR 32, SR133, SR68 & I-275.

From I-275: Exit 63B. Exit on SR 32 towards Batavia. Go 13 miles to SR133 (Williamsburg). North (left turn) on SR 133 to Jackson Pike (flashing yellow light). Turn right (East) on Jackson Pike. Location is 1/2 mile on the left. **From the North traveling South on I-71:** take exit #50 (SR 68). Turn left on SR 68. Stay on SR 68 until you come to SR 50. (Fayetteville). Turn right and go 8 miles to SR 133.(Willimsburg).Turn left (South) on SR 133 to Jackson Pike (flashing yellow light).Turn left (East) on Jackson Pike. Location is 1/2 mile on the left.

(Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (Ionghaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
