Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

<u>Jump Height Order</u>

Obedience classes with jumps will be decided after closing Rally classes with jumps will be run tall-to-short all days. Every effort will be made to accommodate handlers with multiple dogs in the same class.

Waiting List

This trial will have a waiting list in the event the limits are reached prior to closing.

Transfers

Transfers will be allowed according to AKC Regulations, provided that the written request is received at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

Notice to Exhibitors

- **THE SAFETY OF DOGS** is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- TELEPHONE, FAXED, INCOMPLETE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.
- ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. <u>Unsigned entries or entries missing information other than the dog's call name will be returned</u>.

If handlers have a ring conflict and so inform the gate steward, every effort will be made to accommodate you.
