DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP),an AKC Canine Partners (mixed breed) listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners (mixed breed) listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter.

Dogs that are both deaf and blind are able to participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

We will be offering a Scent Work Victor/Victrix Award starting in 2024 at the GSDCA National. The criteria are listed below. The Scent Work Victor/Victrix will be awarded from the Master Level and Detective classes during the trial designated as the GSD National Specialty Trial (Monday).

- · Dogs must Qualify in all four Master Scent Work classes in the Odor Search Division.
- · Dogs must compete in the Detective class. A qualifying score is NOT required.
- At least one owner of the dog must be a GSDCA member.
- · The dog must not have any disqualifying faults and must be approved by an AKC German Shepherd Dog judge.
- · The dog must have AKC registration. No ILP/PAL dogs will be eligible.
- · The dog may be spayed or neutered.

Scoring criteria:

The dog must qualify in all four Master Scent Work classes, Interior, Exterior, Buried, and Containers during the designated trial.

The dog must run in Detective in the same designated trial. Successful completion is not required for eligibility.

If more than one dog qualifies in all four elements, their overall score is determined by the dog with the fewest faults across the four

If the faults are equal, then the dog with the fastest time across all four elements breaks the tie.

If the dog qualifies in the Detective class, they will be given either a one fault reduction or a one-minute time reduction from their Master level results. If the dog does not qualify in Detective, there is no adjustment to their Master level results

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all exercises safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The German Shepherd Dog Club of America and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The German Shepherd Dog Club of America reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the German Shepherd Dog Club of America or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when competing in the event

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. **Females in season** are not permitted to compete in scent work. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season, the club will refund entry fees for bitches unable to compete. The Trial Secretary must be notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial. The club will retain a processing fee of \$5.00 per trial.

REWARDS AND REINFORCERS

When a dog correctly finds the scent, the handler may reward the dog with a food or toy reinforcement. Handlers may reward at or away from source but must take care not to contaminate the search area with food particles or saliva. If a toy is used, the toy must always stay in contact with the handler (toys cannot be thrown). Toys that make noise are not allowed. These items are to be used as a reward only and may not be used to bait the dog.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS & HANDLERS
