BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR CLASS

Effective September 18, 2002: 1) All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with the AKC; 2) The individual handling the dog in the Bred-By Class must be a breeder of record and a current owner of record of the dog; 3) To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record. In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-By Class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle the dog.

LISTING OF AGENTS/HANDLERS IN SHOW CATALOGS

To be listed as a handler or agent for a dog in catalogs for events occurring on or after January 1, 2025, individuals must successfully complete the Stewards of Children® course and submit their certificate of completion along with a completed Agent Number Request form to judgecompliance@akc.org. The new agent number should be used for events occurring on or after January 1, 2025, and will be accepted by all superintendents. AKC RHP & PHA Handler numbers will be retained as they are already accepted universally.

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern these events. Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry form that accompanies this Show Premium List.

Dogs need to be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the clubs nor show secretaries will be responsible nor obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class being judged. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates.

Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the judging of a class. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dog(s) in the judging ring.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or a judge; or barred from competition due to their violation of any rules or regulations set forth by the show-giving clubs.

NO FAX ENTRIES. Any overnight private carriers requiring a signature upon delivery will not be guaranteed to be received in time to meet required deadline for closing. **PLEASE SPECIFY SIGNATURE NOT REQUIRED.**

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. **Entries must be on Official AKC Entry Forms.** Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by electronic mail, prior to the close of entries. Entries received by telephone are not acceptable.

No fees will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the show-giving club or show secretary.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be \$40 fee on returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash only basis. Canadian exhibitors: make checks/money orders in U.S. funds.

Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program sent to email address on entry form. Should exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time contact the Show Secretary.

Refunds for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to closing.

If veterinary attention is required, the exhibitor is responsible for the veterinarian's emergency fee and medical expenses incurred.

LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.

ALL videotaping or photography during the show requires permission from the show-giving club.

ONLY THE OFFICIAL SHOW PHOTOGRAPHER MAY TAKE WIN PHOTOS WHICH INCLUDE THE JUDGE.

ALL prizes must be claimed the day of the show—none will be mailed.

BELOW ARE RULES THAT MUST BE FOLLOWED:

1. ALL DOGS TO BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY, both at the show site and at area hotels (if so designated).
2. Dogs must be kept on leash at all times while on show or hotel grounds.
3. Limit of 2 dogs per hotel room (unless otherwise specified)
4. Unattended dogs must be crated in hotel rooms.
5. Absolutely no bathing or grooming of dogs is allowed in hotel rooms.
6. Dog owners/agents are responsible for timely clean up and disposal of any waste – both at show grounds and at their respective hotels.
7. Dog owners and/or their agents are personally responsible to area hotels for any damage caused thru their negligence.

PLEASE BE A COURTEOUS AND RESPONSIBLE DOG GUEST.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

- A. From the north (east or west), take I-96 to US 23 South. Go approximately 6 miles to the Whitmore Lake Exit (Exit 53). Turn LEFT onto 8-Mile Rd, cross over US-23 and go about ¼ mile (past the on ramp). Turn LEFT onto North Main St. (just before edge of lake), then a quick LEFT into Days Inn driveway (just before carwash).
- B. From the south and west, take I-94 East to Route 14 North/East. Take exit for US 23 North. Take the Whitmore Lake Exit and follow directions above in Section A.
- C. From the south and east, take I-94 West to US 23 North. Proceed to the Whitmore Lake Exit and follow the directions in Section A.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
