## **BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR CLASS**

Effective September 18, 2002: 1) All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with the AKC; 2) The individual handling the dog in the Bred-By Class must be a breeder of record and a current owner of record of the dog; 3) To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record. In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-By Class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle the dog.

## **LISTING OF AGENTS/HANDLERS IN SHOW CATALOGS**

To be listed as a handler or agent for a dog in catalogs for events occurring on or after January 1, 2025, individuals must successfully complete the Stewards of Children® course and submit their certificate of completion along with a completed Agent Number Request form to [judgecompliance@akc.org](mailto:judgecompliance@akc.org). The new agent number should be used for events occurring on or after January 1, 2025, and will be accepted by all superintendents. AKC RHP & PHA Handler numbers will be retained as they are already accepted universally.

## **EXIBITORS – PLEASE NOTE**

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern these events. Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry form that accompanies this Show Premium List.

Dogs need to be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the clubs nor show secretaries will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class being judged. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates.

Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the judging of a class. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dog(s) in the judging ring.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or a judge; or barred from competition by the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete because it is incorrectly entered.

**NO FAX ENTRIES.** Any overnight private carriers requiring a signature upon delivery will not be guaranteed to be received in time to meet required deadline for closing.

**No** entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. **Entries must be on Official AKC Entry Forms.** Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by electronic mail, prior to the close of entries. Entries received by telephone are not acceptable.

**No fees** will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the show-giving club or show secretary.

**Returned** checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be \$40 fee on returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash only basis. Canadian exhibitors: make checks/money orders in U.S. funds.

**Entries** will be acknowledged after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program sent to email address on entry form if available. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within 7 days of the event, contact the show secretary.

**Refunds** for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to closing.

If veterinary attention is required, the exhibitor is responsible for the veterinarian's emergency fee and medical expenses incurred.

**The GSDC of MSP** may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other causes and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the host club or any official thereof.

**LOSS OR DAMAGE** – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.

**THE GSDC OF MINNEAPOLIS & ST PAUL, INC.**, its show secretary, Washington County Fairgrounds, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors, handlers, their employees, or children, etc., or to any of their dogs or property. Entrants and spectators to these events do so entirely at their own risk. Nor are the named parties responsible for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any participant, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at these shows is in the care, custody, and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

**All prizes** will be awarded in the ring. The Club reserves the right to substitute any trophy with one of greater or equal value if necessary.

**ALL** prizes must be claimed the day of the show—none will be mailed.

**ALL** videotaping or photography during the show requires permission from the show-giving club.

**ONLY THE OFFICIAL SHOW PHOTOGRAPHER MAY TAKE WIN PHOTOS WHICH INCLUDE THE JUDGE.**

**BELOW ARE RULES THAT MUST BE FOLLOWED:**

1. ALL DOGS TO BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY, both at the show site and at area hotels (if so designated).
2. Dogs must be kept on leash at all times while on show or hotel grounds.
3. Limit of 2 dogs per hotel room (unless otherwise specified)
4. Unattended dogs must be crated in hotel rooms.
5. Absolutely no bathing or grooming of dogs is allowed in hotel rooms.
6. Dog owners/agents are responsible for timely clean up and disposal of any waste – both at show grounds and at their respective hotels. Dog owners and/or their agents are personally responsible to area hotels for any damage caused thru their negligence.

**From North/Hwy I-35**

Take I-35 South to I-35E. Take I-35E south for approx 13 miles to I-694 East exit. Continue east on I-694 for approx 5-1/2 miles to Exit 52B/Hwy 36. Continue east on Hwy 36 for approx 6 miles to Stillwater Blvd/County 14. Take a right heading south on Stillwater Blvd and continue for 2 miles to fairgrounds on the left.

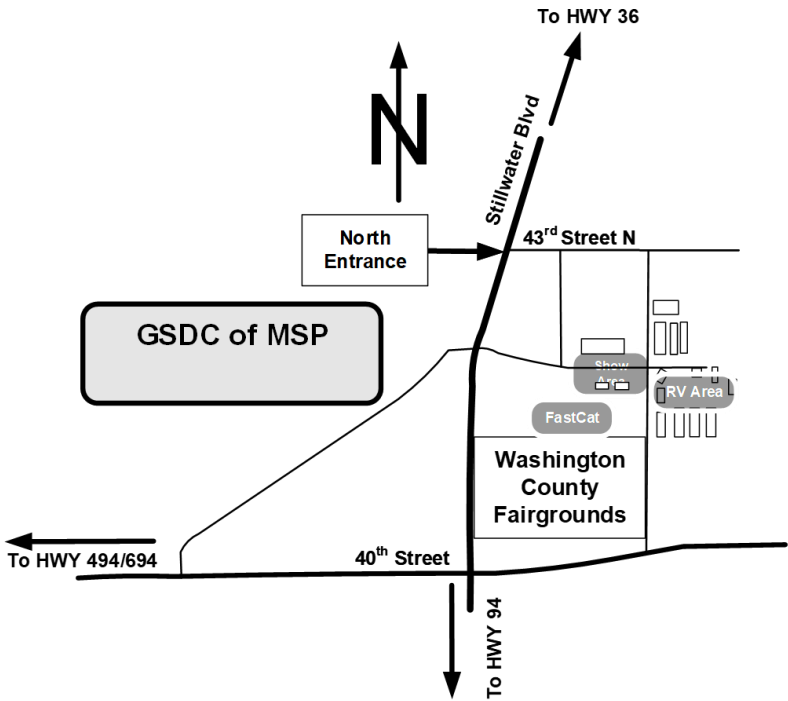
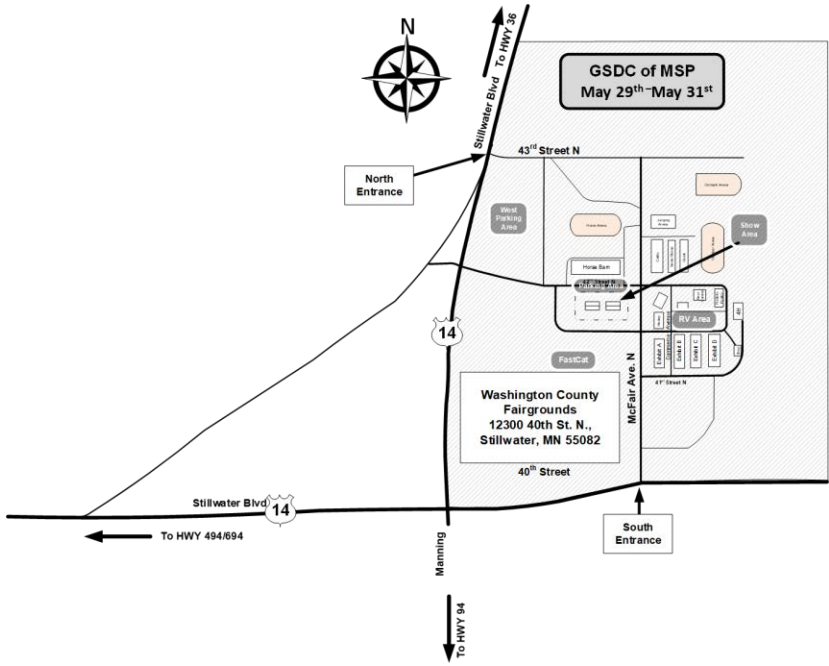
Take I-94 East to Manning Ave. Head north on Manning for approx 5 miles to fairgrounds.

### INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
