#### AKC National owner-Handled Series

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers\*, household members and current assistants\*\* to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. For a detailed description of the National Owner-Handled Series, please visit the AKC website NOHS pages.

\*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. \*\*A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

#### BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR CLASS

Effective September 18, 2002: 1) All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with the AKC; 2) The individual handling the dog in the Bred-By Class must be a breeder of record and a current owner of record of the dog; 3) To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record. In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-By Class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle the dog.

**Junior Showmanship Competition** offered Friday & Saturday PM shows only

**Novice Junior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who have not won three First Places in a Novice Class.

**Novice Intermediate Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who have not won three First Places in a Novice Class.

**Novice Senior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show who have not won three First Places in a Novice Class.

**Open Junior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and have won three First Places in a Novice Class.

**Open Intermediate Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who have won three First Places in a Novice Class.

**Open Senior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and have won three First Places in a Novice Class.

**Master Class:** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with Competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 – October 31 of the following year.

### From Greenfield, MA

Get on I-91 N/MA-2. Continue to follow I-91 N (You'll enter Vermont). Take exit 3 for US-5/VT-9 E toward Brattleboro/Keene N.H. Continue onto Chesterfield Rd and at the traffic circle, take the 2nd exit onto Chesterfield Rd/Rte 9 E. Continue onto NH-9 E (entering New Hampshire). At the traffic circle, take the 2nd exit and stay on NH-9 E. Turn left onto NH-10 N/NH-12 N/NH-9 E/Rte 12 for 1.3 miles, then Turn right onto NH-10 N/NH-9 E (signs for Concord/Newport). Continue to follow NH-9 E, then NH-123 S to Middle Rd in Hancock, NH. Turn right onto NH-123 S. Follow to NH-137 and take a sharp right onto NH-137 S/Bonds Corner Rd/Old Hancock Rd, Continue to follow NH-137 S/Bonds Corner Rd, then left onto Middle Rd to #23.

### From Hartford, CT.

Follow I-91 N to Chesterfield Rd in Brattleboro. Take exit 3 from I-91 N for US-5/VT-9 E toward Brattleboro/Keene N.H Follow NH-9 E and NH-123 S to Middle Rd in Hancock. Sharp right onto NH-137 S/Bonds Corner Rd/Old Hancock Rd. Continue to follow NH-137 S/Bonds Corner Rd 0.4 mi Turn left onto Middle Rd.

### From Providence RI.

Take RI-146 N to Worcester. Take exit 21 from MA-146 N/Worcester-Providence Turnpike, then take I-190 N to Rt 2 W. Take exit 100 from MA-2 W, then take MA-13 N. Turn right onto MA-13 N/MA-2A E, Turn left onto MA-13 N, Turn left onto W Townsend Rd. Continue onto Lunenburg Rd, Continue onto W Elm St, Turn right onto Main St, Turn left onto Canal St, Continue onto Mason Rd. Continue straight onto Greenville Rd, you will entering New Hampshire. Continue onto Barrett Hill Rd, then Continue onto NH-124 W. Turn right onto NH-123 N, Turn left onto NH-123 N/State Rte 101 W/Wilton Rd. Turn right onto Granite St, Merge onto Pine St, Continue onto US-202 E/Concord St. Turn left onto NH-123 N. Turn left onto Tannery Hill Rd, Turn right onto Middle Rd to 23 Middle Rd.

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern these Events. Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry form that accompanies this Show Premium List.

Fees include the \$4.00 AKC Event Service Fee and \$.50 AKC Recording Fee on the first entry of each dog for the first entry of a dog and a \$4.50 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single-entry classes.

ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee of \$40 to the amount of each returned check. TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE and UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS AND PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made. ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the club it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Refunds for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$4.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to closing.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES will be made via email to the email address shown on entry form as soon as practicable with the judging program. SHOULD SUCH ACKNOWLEDGEMENT NOT BE RECEIVED BY THE EXHIBITOR within a reasonable time, please notify the show secretary.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. DOGS NOT REQUIRED for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The Show-giving club and the Superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercise ring.

EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and vehicles.

LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children. The GSDCCM and the GSDCSNH will not be responsible for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog at the show or in transit to the show, or for the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at the show is in the care and custody and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Refund and Cash award checks are void after 180 days and will NOT be re-issued.

If veterinary attention is required, the exhibitor is responsible for the veterinarian's emergency fee and medical expenses incurred. Pursuant to New Hampshire State Health requirements, proof of current rabies vaccination must be available if requested.

ALL videotaping or photography during the show requires permission from the show-giving club.

The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division. 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who
