GSDCA Phyllis Dobbs Versatility Competition

(Most Versatile German Shepherd Competition at the GSDCA National)

Overview: The *Most Versatile German Shepherd Competition* (“Versatility Competition”) is in memory of Phyllis Dobbs, who bred, owned, and trained the first Triple Champion in the German Shepherd breed. The Versatility Competition recognizes those dogs that exemplify true versatility by successfully competing in a variety of events during the GSDCA National.

The Versatility Competition is open to all AKC registered or listed German Shepherd Dogs. The dogs in the Versatility Competition must be currently owned by at least one member of the GSDCA in good standing. Dogs must compete at the National in a minimum of **three** of the following venues: **Agility, Conformation, Herding, Obedience/Rally, Scent Work/Tracking**. Obedience and Rally are considered one venue since the required skills are similar. Scent Work and Tracking will be considered one venue for the purpose of the Versatility Competition.

To participate in the Versatility Competition, competitors must fill out a Versatility Competition registration form and submit it with the registration fee by August 24, 2026, to ensure being listed in the catalog as being entered in the Versatility Competition. Participants must enter the events in which their dog will compete directly with the appropriate event secretary. There is no registration fee to participate in the Versatility Competition.

During the National Specialty, participants must fill out and turn in a score sheet to the Versatility Competition Chair each day after each sport has been completed. The scoring for the competition ends after the conclusion of the Best of Breed competition; the winner of the Versatility Competition will be announced during the Victory Banquet and be presented with the Phyllis Dobbs Versatility Award. Competing dogs will receive a customized participation rosette. The winner of the 2026 Phyllis Dobbs Versatility Award will receive a cold cast bronze statue of a German Shepherd Dog.

Scoring: The Versatility Competition is based on a point accumulation system based on performance in various events. A dog can earn a maximum of 800 points per sport. Points will be awarded in Conformation for participation and placement. Points will be awarded in each performance event entered based on:

- Qualifying runs
- Maximum of 2 weighted scores (if applicable)
- Additional points may be awarded for certain special achievements (e.g., High in Trial in Obedience).

Although Obedience and Rally are considered a single event for purposes of the three event minimum, competitors can earn points from both Obedience and Rally.

Agility: Any two qualifying runs that receive a score (Standard, Jumpers, FAST, Premier) on Monday and Tuesday will count as weighted scores towards the total points awarded in the Versatility Competition. Versatility points will be computed as RAW SCORE plus points.

Conformation: A dog may compete in both the Versatility Sweeps (a conformation class open only to dogs entered in the Versatility Competition), and in the regular conformation classes. All dogs participating (and not being excused for DQs or temperament), will receive 25 points for participation in the sweepstakes or in any regular conformation class during the National. Class placements will be awarded additional points. Dogs competing in Best of Breed will receive 100 participation points, earning a Select, GV, GVX, or BOB will receive additional points.

Versatility Conformation Sweepstakes: *The purpose of offering a Versatility Sweepstakes class is so all Versatility dogs, even those that are spayed or neutered, may compete and earn participation points in conformation. The sweepstakes will offer two classes, dogs and bitches, and will be judged prior to the Futurity finals. Judge TBD. This is a non-regular class and must be entered and paid for via the Versatility Competition Registration Form.*

Herding: Any two qualifying runs that receive a score (Course A, B, C, D on ducks or sheep) from the GSDCA herding trials will count as weighted scores towards the total points awarded in the Versatility Competition. Versatility points will be computed as RAW SCORE plus points. Although only two qualifying runs receive a weighted score, all other qualifying runs will receive points.

Obedience/Rally: Obedience and Rally are combined as one venue since the skills are very similar. However, dogs may earn 2 raw scores in each event. Any two qualifying runs that receive a score will count as weighted scores towards the total points awarded in the Versatility Competition. Because Obedience scores are based on a 200 point scale (unlike the other performance venues that are a 100 point scale) Obedience Versatility points will be computed as 50% of the RAW SCORE plus points. Rally Versatility points will be computed as RAW SCORE plus points. Although only two qualifying runs from EACH event (Obedience and Rally) receive a weighted score, all other qualifying runs will receive points.

Scent Work: Scent Work is a pass/fail event. A dog may earn points for up to 10 qualifying legs. The dog earns points for Qs along with placements and HITs. You can earn Versatility points in any of the four Scent Work trials on Friday or Saturday.

Tracking: Tracking is the only sport for which points are awarded for previously earned titles. Tracking will only count as one the three required venues if dogs are entered and qualify at the National. To encourage people to enter the Tracking test at the National Specialty, dogs qualifying at the National will earn more points than dogs with a previously earned title. Any update or corrections will be in the 2026 GSDCA Official Premium List.

ELIGIBILITY: Champions with certified hips/elbows, OFA, OVC or SV "a" Stamp Normal certified after the age of 24 mo. who are in competition for and receive the Select rating at the GSDCA National. Dogs/Bitches entered in non-regular classes (Veterans) that move up to BOB competition and Winners Dog/Bitch with certified hips/elbows and receive a Select rating are eligible.

Complete documentation must be received by Friday, September 18, 2026. Winners at the national must give the proper certification to the Chairman by 5:00 p.m. the night BEFORE judging of Best of Breed on Saturday.

After the closing date, dogs still awaiting certification from that period until the National: Required information must be given to the Show Chairman, no later than 5:00 p.m. the day before Best Of Breed judging. Be prepared with needed information as without proper ID, there can be no exceptions. Owners of all dogs/bitches with a Sel. Excellent rating from a past national, will need to send documentation to this year's Chair.

GSDCA PARADE OF GREATS ENTRIES CLOSE August 1, 2026 – NO EXCEPTIONS

Entries must be SEVEN years of age by August 1, 2026, except GV, GVX, AOE, ROM, and PAM. This parade is an acknowledgment of Great Dogs, their Longevity, and their Accomplishments.

GROUP I – CONFORMATION

1. Former Grand Victors or Victrixes of U.S. or Canada
2. Any AOE Recipient
3. Select Dogs and Bitches (U.S. only)
4. ROM Sires and Dams
5. Champions with an advanced performance title, i.e., UD, AX, AXJ, HX, IPOIII, TDX, VST
6. Former North American Sieger or Siegrems
7. VA's from Germany
8. Highest winning GSD as per AKC records indicating total number of dogs, any breed, defeated in a given year

GROUP II – PERFORMANCE

1. Performance Victors or Victrixes, including Obedience, Herding, and Agility (U.S. only). Dogs must be free of disqualifying faults according to the Breed Standard except for those earning titles in 2013.
2. Performance Award of Merit dogs and bitches
3. Performance Champions, including Obedience, Herding, Agility, and Tracking
4. Schutzhund III dogs and bitches (trained in the U.S. only)

GROUP III – SERVICE DOGS – which can include

1. Guide Dog
2. Mobility Assistance Dog
3. Hearing Dog
4. Medical Assistance Dog
 - A. Certified Search and Rescue Dogs (SAR) Requirements Include:
 - 1) Owner must provide a certificate from the SAR team as proof of completion of testing for certification
 - 2) Owner must provide proof that their dog was trained under the guidelines and standards of the National Association for Search and Rescue (NASAR)
 - 3) Document showing proof of service (ie. Individual SAR team leader, public safety agency representative, or any other agency)
 - B. Categories
 - 1) SAR Dogs
 - 2) Cadaver Dogs (trained to find human remains)
 - 3) Wilderness Search Dogs (trained to find missing persons in the wild and in cities)
 - 4) Drowned Victim Recovery Dogs (trained to work in and around water searching for human remains)

- 5) Urban Search Dogs (trained to search for victims of natural or man-made disasters)

GROUP IV – THERAPY DOGS

1. Dogs who have earned an AKC therapy title (ThD)
2. Therapy dogs who have made 50 visits that are certified by AKC-approved therapy dog Organizations (ex., TDI, Delta, etc._
3. Psychological Therapy Dogs

PARADE OF GREATS - General Information

1. If an animal is in poor health (lame) it can still be presented, BUT NOT GAITED
2. The acquired title must be officially awarded by August 15, 2026, and the verification of that title will be included with the entry
3. A FEE of \$50 will be charged to cover the cost of Rosettes and Page in the National Catalog. **Please pay through the GSDCA store.**
4. Rosettes must be picked up at the National Specialty, none will be mailed
5. Dogs must be presented in the Parade to have their presentation speech read
6. Only AKC, CKC, and WDA titles will be listed in the catalog and on the Presentation Ribbon
7. Dogs must have individual handlers and be presented one at a time
8. Dogs shown in the Parade of Greats CANNOT be shown in Best of Breed competition at that year's National

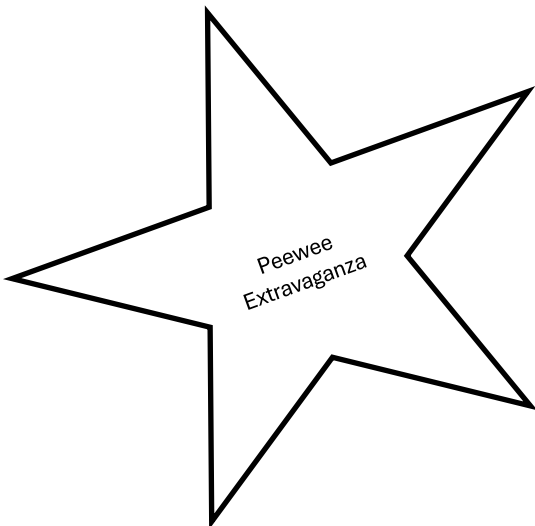
